Students wishing to obtain a PhD minor in Print Culture History from the Information School:

A GPA of 3.0 must be maintained in the minor. Twelve credits are required. All courses must be 300 level or above, taken after the bachelor's degree. Ordinarily, only one course (maximum 3 credits) of independent study is allowed (for instance, 699, 799, 999). No more than 5 credits completed 5 or more years prior to admission to Ph.D. major may be used. Courses taken 10 or more years ago may not be used. Courses taken for pass/fail or for audit may not be used. Courses with grades of S (Satisfactory) or Cr (credit) are acceptable. PhD minors may need to seek additional permissions to enroll in Information School online courses due to the need to preserve space for online MA program students.
