**UW-Madison iSchool Class of 2019 – A Brief Overview**

The University of Wisconsin-Madison Information School graduated 81 master’s students in May, August, and December 2018. Thirty-two of the graduates responded to the employment survey. Of respondents, the majority (97%) reported being employed. That number increases to 100% if the one person who continued graduate studies, and therefore is not employed, is not counted. Of the respondents, 31% reported finding jobs before graduation and 34% returned to a previous (or ongoing) employer. About half of the respondents (53%) reported working in public or academic libraries, and 44% reported employment in other information environments including government agencies, private industry, and school libraries.

The mean salary reported was \$54,110. The median was \$47,000. Hourly salary rates reported were highly variable ranging from \$13 an hour to \$50 an hour. The mean reported hourly salary rate was \$23.88. The median was \$21.35.
